

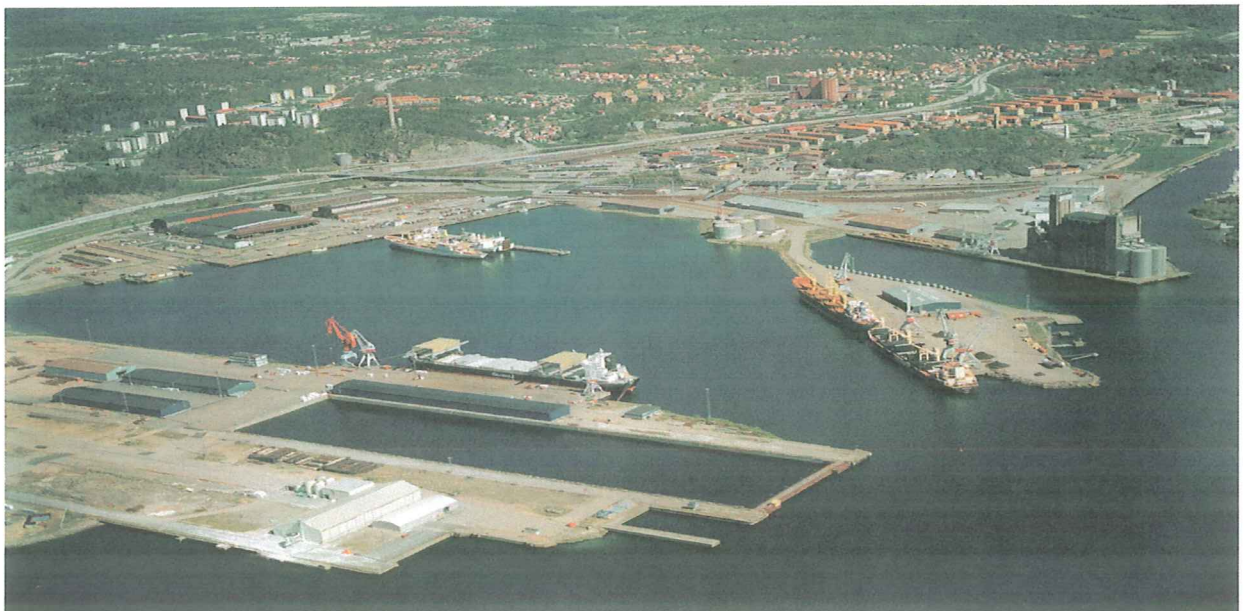

INFORMATION REGARDING THE PORT SECURITY IN THOSE PARTS OF PORT OF UDDEVALLA IS OPERATED BY UDDEVALLA HAMNTERMINAL AB*

This information is based on the international regulations concerning Port Security (ISPS Code) and which are valid from 1 July 2004. The aim is to clarify which rules are valid in the areas concerned

Notification on delivery

Arriving vessels should, not later than 24 hours before arrival, notify the port under what security level they are and the security level in the 10 last ports of call. Preferably the agent is informed, who has to pass the information to UHTAB.

Designated ISPS areas

The areas that have been designated as ISPS areas will be seen from the attached maps over the port areas.

Gates for crew entrance are also shown. The areas concerned are marked as follows



Please observe that anyone found within those areas may be subject to an identification control/visitation.

Crews identifications document

Crewmembers who are within ISPS areas shall on request prove their identity by presenting a valid seaman's book or an ID issued by IMO. Omission to show a valid identification document will be a matter for the Police.

Entrycards

Each vessel will upon arrival receive a number of entry cards to the restricted areas. Those cards have a limited validity in respect of time and access gates. Vessel will be charged for cards not returned to vessel's agent prior departure.

Declaration of security

In case that a vessel maintains a higher security level than the level existing in port or considers that they need extended security shall request a declaration of security to be issued. The request is put to the PFSO or to the deputy PFSO in charge. Information is given on telephone +46(0)52291200 (24 hrs service). Vessel will be charged all additional costs in respect of such request.

Vessels who are not in compliance with the ISPS code

Vessels not in compliance with the code or arrive from a last port call that do not fulfill the obligations set out in the code will be charged all additional costs related to security matters.
